Birthday Party

FAQ'S

1. Do infants under 1 count as part of the head count?

No. Only guests that have had their 2nd birthday and older are part of your head count.

2. How late can I add guests to the total number of guests?

You can add guests at any time. We only require a \$75 deposit to reserve your date, time slot and tables. You are not required to pay the remaining balance until the end of the party. We do this because we understand how hard it is to get firm RSVP's and things are always subject to change at the last minute. Experience has shown that offering our guests this flexibility makes the birthday party planning process much easier.

As your guests arrive the day of your party they must check-in at admissions to receive an armband allowing entry to the farm. Our cashier keeps a running tally of all guests (children and adults) that have checked in for your party. At the end of your party you will check-out and the cashier will go over how many total guests you had so that way you are not having to worry with overpaying for no-shows or under-paying for unexpected guests.

NOTE: If you do not plan to include adults in your party guest-count, then you will need to let our cashier know upon your check-in for the party so she will know to collect admissions from them as they arrive.

3. Can I bring in additional drinks or purchase from you?

Birthday cake (and/or cupcakes) and ice cream are the only outside food permitted. Your package comes with one gallon pitcher of lemonade and one gallon pitcher of water. Additionally, we provide cups and ice. You may also bring in one bottle of water per guest for your party.

We offer discounted food/beverage options with a 5 day advanced order. Food must be paid-in-full at the time of placing your order. Our [Birthday Party menu](#) offers lots of options with discounted pricing. Utensils, plates, napkins and condiments are included with food orders.

Guests may also purchase food/beverages from our concessions stand on the day of your event, however, they will be charged at the full menu price.

4. How much can I decorate the assigned tables?

You can decorate as much or as little as you like. You are assigned four picnic tables for use during your scheduled party time. You will need to decide in advance how you plan to use those tables. You are welcome to bring themed balloons, table clothes, goody bags, centerpieces, plates and napkins. You may arrive 15 minutes prior to the start of your reservation to set-up and decorate.

We do not allow any decorations to be taped, stapled or nailed to any of our tables, buildings or trees. Also, silly string, confetti, piñatas, streamers, shredded stuffing, glass containers and whistles are prohibited as they all pose choking risks to our animals should the debris end up in our pastures. Additional tables may be reserved for \$15.00 per table for your two hour time period.

5. Is the picnic table area covered?

Picnic tables are assigned to different locations around the farm. Depending on the anticipated crowds for the day, your assigned tables may be located under our main pavilion or in one of the shade tree groves situated next to the playgrounds.

6. How long is a party?

Your party can last from open to close, however, your tables are reserved for 2 hours. Most families prefer to have their parties start at their tables and then enjoy the activities around the farm. Please be mindful of parties that may be scheduled after yours by cleaning up and removing your items after your time has ended.

7. Do you provide an invitation?

8. Can we barbecue?

Grilling is prohibited.

9. What about alcohol and smoking?

There is no alcohol or smoking on the farm. Visitors may smoke in their vehicle in the parking lot.

10. May we bring our dog?

We love dogs, but for the safety of our animals and other guests on the property, we do not permit pets on the property.
